Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case for promotion of the petitioner to the post of a Middle Head, has been recommended by the Principal of the Government Middle School, Bhiwani, to the Block Education Officer, Bhiwani, vide the communication Annexure P-6, but no decision has been taken thereon.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents, to take a decision on the aforesaid communication, Annexure P-6, by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If it is found that juniors to the petitioner had been promoted prior to him, then the petitioner would be entitled to all consequential benefits, it not being his fault that he was not promoted along with the juniors.

However, if for any reason (other than not having worked on the post), the petitioner is considered to be not eligible for the arrears of pay, such detailed reasons shall be given in the speaking order to be passed.
