Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, has submitted that this Court vide its order dated 21.12.2016 passed in CWP No.22108 of 2016 had already directed the Superintending Canal Officer [hereinafter referred to as 'the SCO'] to entertain the revision petition but still the SCO is not entertaining the revision petition.

In view thereof, the only remedy available with the petitioner is of filing a contempt petition under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 but separate writ petition for the implementation of the order passed by this Court is not maintainable.

Faced with this observation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to file contempt petition at the first instance.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
