In the present writ petition, petitioner has challenged the award passed by the Labour court dated 04.08.2017 (Annexure P3). One of the contention raised by the petitioner is that respondent-workman has abandoned the services. This fact has not been appreciated by the Labour Court. To that extent there is error apparent on the face of the labour court award. Perusal of the award what has been granted to the respondent-workman is compensation of Rs.40,000/-. Therefore, it may not be appropriate to set aside the award and remand the matter for deciding the reference afresh. Accordingly, CWP stands dismissed.
