The petitioners at this stage seek an order directing the respondents to reply the advocate's notice dated 21.09.2017 (Annexure P-4).

The petition is disposed of directing the respondents to reply to said notice as expeditiously as possible.

Needless to add that even if the proceedings for resumption are initiated, the petitioners can always raise all the contentions including those in the said notice. The petitioners are at liberty to pay the amounts without prejudice to their rights and contentions. In the event of the respondents accepting the amounts and the petitioners ultimately succeeding, the respondents would have returned the same with interest as may be fixed by the Court. The petitioners would also be entitled to raise any other contentions at the appropriate stage.
