It is alleged in the writ petition that despite categorical order passed by this Court on 03.10.2017 directing that *status-quo* re: possession be maintained till the stay application filed by the petitioners is decided by the Appellate Authority, the respondents in willful disobedience of those directions have decided to initiate the auction proceedings.

In our considered view, if there is any willful disobedience of the directions issued by this Court, the appropriate remedy for the petitioners lies somewhere else.

With liberty aforementioned the writ petition is disposed of.

The auction, if any conducted meanwhile, shall be subject to final outcome of the proceedings which the petitioners may initiate.
