The petitioners want to enforce Rule 12(4) of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Rules, 1964, as applicable to the State of Haryana, against the Gram Panchayat of their village for which they have not even approached the Gram Panchayat so far.

The writ petition is thus disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to represent and persuade the Gram Panchayat for passing a resolution for selling 200 square yard plots to each one of them in terms of Rule 12(4) of the 1964 Rules. In the event of inaction on the part of the Gram Panchayat, the petitioners shall be at liberty to approach the higher authorities before rushing to this Court.

With liberty aforementioned, the writ petition is disposed of.
