1. The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 22.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) by taking immediate steps for closing all the illegal institutions i.e. brick kilns, saw mills, illegal curser & cement shops on the road, which are spreading pollution and creating environment imbalance in the area of Punahana Mewat.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that inadvertently certain factual matrix could not be incorporated and relevant documents appended along with the

present writ petition. Accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh writ petition on the same cause of action by furnishing complete and better particulars.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
