The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, by way of Public Interest Litigation (PIL), seeking direction to respondents No.3 & 4 to ensure restraining mining activities in illegal manner carried out by respondents No.6 & 7 in the area for public safety, protection of environment and village, maintaining ecological balance and to do the work as per the Rules and norms framed by the concerned authority and to take action against the culprits and directing respondents No.6 & 7 to fulfill the damages caused by them to reconstruct/re-build the roads and dykes of the concerned area.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to pursue the representation which has been filed before the respondent-authorities.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
