Vide impugned letter dated 25.01.2017 Annexure P-7, the respondents, in pursuance to the observations of the Commission of Inquiry, has ordered that the disbursement of the compensation on account of loss suffered due to the death of Ishwar Singh Chandhok, should be disbursed between all the legal heirs of Ishwar Singh Chandhok.

The petitioner claims that since he was the only applicant, the amount should not be paid to the other legal heirs.

The present petition seeking disbursement of the compensation exclusively to the petitioner without impleading the other affected persons, who are likely to be affected, is not maintainable. The petition is thus liable to be dismissed on this score.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh petition by impleading the necessary parties.

Dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.
