1. The prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release an amount of ₹ 11,78,815/- along with interest @ 9%, illegally deducted as TDS on the amount of compensation of land acquisition out of ₹ 58,94,077/-.
2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Income Tax Department to raise all the pleas as raised in the present writ petition.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
