As per the pleadings on record, the petitioner joined as Clerk under the Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Limited (PUNSUP) on 10.12.1984. The petitioner was promoted as Senior Assistant (Accounts) on 09.01.2009 vide order dated 23.01.2014. Petitioner was reverted to her original post of Clerk on the ground that she did not possess the requisite qualification of B.Com with five years experience. The petitioner has no grouse in so far as the reversion directed vide order dated 23.01.2014.

The petitioner earlier approached this Court by filing ***CWP No.24290 of 2016*** raising a claim that even though she had discharged the duties and responsibilities of the post of Senior Assistant (Accounts) from 09.01.2009 till her date of reversion i.e. 23.01.2014, yet she has not been released the emoluments admissible to the promotional post.

CWP No.24290 of 2016 was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 01.03.2017 (Annexure P-3) with a direction to the respondent-Corporation to pass a speaking order as regards her claim.

Placed on record at Annexure P-4 is an order dated 05.06.2017 issued by the District Manager, PUNSUP, Amritsar whereby the pay of the petitioner for the period 10.01.2009 to 23.01.2014 against the promotional post of Senior Assistant (Accounts) has been fixed.

The instant petition has been filed raising a grievance that the order dated 05.06.2017 (Annexure P-4) has not been implemented till date and the requisite financial benefits have not been released.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length, this Court is of the considered view that in exercise of its writ jurisdiction, this Court would not take upon itself the role of a Supervisory Authority as regards any order that may have been passed by an official of the rank of the District Manager under the respondent-corporation.

Without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the present petition and without going into the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.2 i.e. the Managing Director of the Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Limited with regard to her grievance as regards non-implementation of the order dated 05.06.2017 (Annexure P-4) passed by a Subordinate Authority.

Petition is disposed of.
