As informed by learned counsel for respondent No.1-University, the last date for admission to B.Sc. (Post Basic) Nursing Course for the session 2017-18 expired on 15.11.2017. There is no further extension in the last date for admissions given by the University. The petitioner in the instant case approached this Court only on 18.11.2017 when the last date for admissions was already over. That apart, it is the categorical stand taken by learned counsel for Punjab Nurses Registration Council that the petitioner was required to undertake training in Civil Hospital for not less than six months with 100% attendance so as to become eligible for declaration of her result of 3rd year GNM course. In the case in hand, petitioner's certificate (P-5) clearly reveals that she has undergone training for 5 months and 13 days only.

Learned counsel for Punjab Nurses Registration Council further states that as soon as the petitioner's Institute, namely, Royal Institute of Nursing-respondent No.3 would forward the complete details of attendance

alongwith marks of internship, the Punjab Nurses Registration Council shall declare her result within 10 days.

In view of the above stand taken by the respondent-Council, we are satisfied that no direction can be issued to grant admission to the petitioner in B.Sc. (Post Basic) Nursing Course for the session 2017-18. However, respondent No.3-Institute is directed to submit the details of attendance and marks of internship of all the students including the petitioner, to Punjab Nurses Registration Council at the earliest, whereupon the Nurses Registration Council shall declare the result within ten days as per its undertaking.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
