Challenge in the present writ petition is to the orders dated 03.12.2011 (Annexure P-4) and 19.02.2014 (Annexure P-6), whereby arms licence of the petitioner after compliance of the principle of natural justice, has been cancelled on the basis of the complaint made by the wife of the petitioner on account of breach of peace.

Mr. Malkeet Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing had suffered a statement that wife is living with the petitioner and this Court had called upon the petitioner to file the affidavit.

There is no compliance of the aforementioned order. It appears that apprehension in the complaint given by the wife of the petitioner is found to be correct. The petitioner had been found to be picking up frequent

quarrel with his wife. Even the proceedings under Sections 107/151 Cr.P.C. had been initiated against him on 23.07.2011.

In my view, preventing measures of the cancellation of licence is the best remedy. Impugned orders are perfect, legal and justified.

No ground for interference is made out.

Accordingly, present writ petition is dismissed.
