By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant her family pension on account of death of her husband-Sukhwant Singh, who died during service along-with interest @ 18% per annum on the delayed payment(s).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that with regard to the relief claimed by the petitioner through the instant petition, she made a representation dated August 11, 2017 (P-9) but till date neither any reply to the said representation has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the afore-said representation (P-9) in a time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation (P-9) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and instructions as well as in view of judgment of Hon'ble Division rendered in CWP No.2371 of 2010 (P-6), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
