By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the arrears of salary to her in the revised pay scales as per the recommendations made by the 5th Pay Commission for the period January 01, 2006 to August 21, 2009 and thereafter, till the date of her retirement with further direction to revise the gratuity and leave encashment and pay the arrears thereof, along-with benefits of ACP scales granted on completion of service of 8-16-24 years.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that though a legal notice date July 17, 2017 (P-2) was served upon the respondents but till date neither any reply to the said notice has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to consider and decide the afore-said legal notice (P-2) in a time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her legal notice (P-2) and to decide the same in accordance with law, rules and instructions as well as in view of judgments Annexures P-3 to P-5, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
