In respect of the grievances of the petitioner, his father is stated to have made a representation by an Email to the Dean of the respondent-PGIMS, Rohtak, on 09.11.2017 (a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-8 with the petition).

The petitioner is seeking a 'No Objection Certificate' (NOC) to enable him to take admission in some course in the USA, in which he has been selected, in which he is expected to join in the Ist week of January 2018.

He is also seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to re-evaluate the papers of his first annual examination as also supplementary examination, which claims, according to the petitioner, are not being entertained on time by the respondents because of the petitioners' father having been “active in getting an order of a Court implemented.”

Without making any comment on the last allegation, since the petitioner is seeking an NOC for admission to a course in the USA in January

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2018, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director, PGIMS, Rohtak, to hear the petitioner on his grievances on 29.11.2017 or immediately within a day or two thereafter, and as regards the issuance of an NOC to the petitioner, a speaking order will be passed within a period of 10 days, thereafter.

As regards the issue of re-evaluation, another 10 days thereafter, is granted to the competent authority, amongst the respondents, to pass a speaking order with regard to the petitioners' claim thereon.
