The petitioners have challenged the validity of the order dated 09.09.2016 passed by the Assistant Collector, Grade-I-cum-Naib-Tehsildar, Dirba and the order of the Financial Commissioner dated 19.07.2017 .

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners raised an oral objection in regard to the partition of the land in question on the ground that they should have been given the land which they had purchased from the other co-sharer.

Learned counsel for the caveator, however, submits that all the stages of partition are already over because the sanad has been prepared on 09.09.2016 and the possession has been delivered on 16.2.2017.

Although learned counsel for the petitioners has denied that the possession has been delivered yet it is not the stage of raising objection in respect of the preparation of Naksha Ada.

In view of the above, there is hardly any merit to interfere in this petition.

Dismissed.
