Petitioners have prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to refund the whole amount of security deposited by them at the time paddy was released to them for selling.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.2 & 3 submits that security amount has been refunded to all the petitioners after making certain deductions as per agreement/norms.

Under the circumstances, no cause of action survives in this petition. Petition is, thus, disposed of. In case petitioners feel that any amount has been wrongly deducted, they shall be entitled to make representation to the Corporation.
