In the instant petition, petitioner has challenged the validity of the transfer order dated 18.09.2017 (Annexure P-3) to the extent that he has been transferred from GE (West) Jalandhar to 652 Engr Plant Unit PIN 91365 c/o 99APO. After receipt of the transfer order, petitioner had submitted representation to retain his services at Jalandhar. Further his superior officer has also supported petitioner's claim. However, Chief Record Officer Engineers Group Records has not passed order either accepting or rejecting the claim of the petitioner in respect of his retention at Jalandhar. Therefore, Chief Record Officer Bengal Engineer Group is hereby directed to consider petitioner's claim of retention at Jalandhar with reference to Annexure P-2 dated 12.03.2012 read with communication dated 4.10.2017 within a period of four weeks from today. Till passing of such speaking order, order of transfer dated 18.09.2017 (Annexure P-3) insofar as petitioner is concerned shall not be given effect.

With the above observation, petition stands disposed of.
