By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant him the benefit of promotional increment(s), in view of circular dated April 23, 1990 (P-1) as well as in view of judgments passed by this Court in CWP No. 10808 of 2007 (P-7), CWP No. 7538 of 2014 (P-8), CWP No. 17270 of 2007 (P-14) and also in view of orders dated May 11, 2015 and June 12, 2015 (P-10 and P-12) with further direction to release the interest @ 18% per annum on the delayed payment(s).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though a representation dated February 28, 2016 (P-3) was made by the petitioner to respondent No.1 but till date no conscious decision has been taken. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that he feels satisfied in case a

direction is issued to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the afore-said representation (P-3) within some stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation (P-3) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case the petitioner still dissatisfied by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
