On the asking of court, Mr.Gaurav Jindal, Addl.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana.

Petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to release amount of Rs.one lac to the petitioner as per Rule 12(4) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Rules. It has been urged before the court that modesty of the petitioner was outraged. As a result FIR No.109 under Sections 323, 34, 341, 354-A(1), 452, 506 IPC and 3(2) of SC/ST Act was registered. Investigation has been completed and challan presented before the competent court. According to learned counsel, petitioner filed representation/legal notice Annexure P/3 for grant of monetary relief under Section 12(4). Petitioner has been held entitled to the amount. However, there is delay in releasing the same.

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that necessary decision shall be taken at the earliest in any case not later than one month.

In view of statement made by him, no further direction is necessary. Disposed of.
