By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to fix his pay in accordance with order dated September 19, 2014 (P-1) passed by the respondents granting stepping up of pay of the petitioner at par with Ghanshyam Das Gogia and release all consequential benefits in the form of arrears of salary, revised retiral benefits etc. along-with interest @ 12 % per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that though a legal notice dated August 26, 2016 (P-8) was served upon the respondents but till neither any reply has been sent nor any action has been taken by the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels

satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents No.1 to consider and decide the afore-said legal notice (P-8) within some stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice (P-8) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case the petitioners still dissatisfied by any order of the afore-said authorities, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
