RAKESH KUMAR JAIN, J.

The petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to decide his application for removal/shifting of the toilet (Sulabh Shauchalaya).

It is averred in the petition that the petitioner has purchased a shop in the grain market, Khijrabad on which he has constructed his residential house as well.

The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondents have constructed a toilet (Sulabh Shauchalaya) in the grain market which is not being maintained and as a result thereof, the toilet is being misused by anti-social elements and is stinking.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after examining the available record, am of the considered opinion that respondents No.1 to 3 can be directed to maintain the said toilet (Sulabh Shauchalaya) and as such they are hereby directed in this regard but it

cannot be ordered to be removed and on that account the writ petition is hereby dismissed.
