By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release all the retiral benefits accrued to the petitioner i.e. GPF, leave encashment, gratuity, grant of regular pension etc. along-with interest @12% w.e.f. 01.03.2017 from the date it became due till its actual realization.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner stood retired on February 28, 2017 on attaining the age of superannuation. Moreover, a period of nine months has elapsed the retiral benefits accrued to the petitioner has not so far been released to him in spite of the fact that the same have already been sanctioned by the competent authority.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to release all the retiral benefits accrued to the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, if there is no legal empediment.

4. However, in case the petitioner still dissatisfied by any order of the afore-said authorities, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
