JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider his claim for grant of pensionary benefits for the service rendered by him in Govt. Sr. Secondary School, Dhanansu from 17.04.1979 to 31.07.1995 after counting service rendered by him from 01.08.1967 to 16.04.1979 in same school against a regular sanctioned post of peon before it was taken over by Punjab Govt. as qualifying service for the purposes of pension and other retiral benefits.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned State counsel that the grievances ventilated by the petitioner through the instant petition has already been considered by the respondents and speaking

order No.11/101-15 ME(5) dated 12.06.2015 (Annexure R-1) has already been passed during the pendency of instant petition whereby it has been observed that the petitioner is entitled to the benefit(s) claimed by him.

3. In view of the passing of speaking order dated 12.06.2015 (Annexure R-1) referred to above, the instant petition has rendered infructuous and it stands disposed of accordingly.
