The present petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the request of the petitioner for his transfer from Mansa to Sri Muktsar Sahib, being handicapped person and the fact that there are vacancies available for the post of Senior Auditor.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per transfer policy dated 11.04.2017, the handicapped persons can be transferred at the nearby place. He further submits that the petitioner has made a representation to the respondent authorities but his case has not been considered. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to consider his representation dated 02.11.2017 (Annexure P-11).

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 02.11.2017 (Annexure P-11) as per transfer policy dated 11.04.2017. In case, the vacant post is there at Sri Muktsar Sahib, the claim of the petitioner be considered as per policy. The necessary exercise be done within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
