The present petition has been filed challenging the order dated 28.08.2017 (Annexure P-1) vide which the petitioner has been placed under suspension.

The petitioner has filed the appeal alongwith an application for stay in which allegedly notice was issued for 26.10.2017 and the record has been summoned. Thereafter, the application for stay was listed on 02.11.2017, 09.11.2017 and 14.11.2017. Now the application is listed for hearing on 30.11.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if his application for stay is decided on the date already fixed i.e. 30.11.2017.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the record, I am of the considered opinion that this petition can be disposed of without issuing notice to the respondents, with a direction to respondent No.1, to decide the application for stay on the date already fixed i.e. 30.11.2017.

Consequently, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the application of the petitioner seeking interim relief on 30.11.2017 or on the next adjourned date which shall not be beyond a period of seven days.
