By these petitions, the petitioners seek appointment as Constables in
the Haryana Police, pursuant to the advertisement issued on 21.07.2008 for filling

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up 5456 posts of Constables, with various corrigenda stated to have been issued thereafter, with the final result having been declared on 27.01.2012.

Though otherwise these petitions would seem to be highly belated however, Mr. Malik, learned senior counsel for the petitioners, points to the judgment of this Court (a co-ordinate Bench), dated 15.03.2017, passed in CWP No. 21343 of 2014 and other connected matters, (with one of those petitions having been filed in the year 2016), by which judgment the claim of the petitioners therein was allowed, with them ordered to be appointed as Constables, upon conversion of the posts advertised in the Ex-Servicemen Category to the General Category, the said posts not having been filled up as sufficient number of candidates had not applied under that category (ESM/DESM).

Upon query, learned State counsel could not deny that the said judgment has become final.

That being so and nothing having been shown to this Court that the cases of the petitioners (in these petitions) are any different, these petitions are allowed, in terms of the aforesaid judgment of this Court dated 15.03.2017, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-9 with CWP 26062 of 2017.

The petitioners would be given appointments if they are otherwise eligible for the post in question, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, with the same benefits to be given to them as given to the petitioners in CWP No. 21343 of 2014 and other connected petitions.
