The petitioner is aggrieved against the order dated 18.11.2015 (Annexure P-1). The petitioner has an efficacious remedy of revision under Section 69 of the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961 as applicable to the Chandigarh.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he would avail the remedy of revision provided the period spent herein be condoned otherwise other party would take the objection qua limitation.

In case, petitioner avails the remedy of revision within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, the period spent herein shall deemed to be condoned and the same shall be

decided within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

In view of the aforementioned observations, present writ petition stands disposed of.
