The petitioner is aggrieved by order dated 31.1.2017 (Annexure P-31). Similar order had been challenged earlier in CWP No. 2505 of 2017 **M/S Suttlej Filling Station vs. Indian Oil Corporation Limited and anr**, which was disposed of on 9.2.2017.

The present writ petition is also disposed of as pre-mature as no legal enforceable right has accrued to the petitioner to challenge any illegal action of the respondents. However, a direction is issued that in case of non compliance of the requisite information as per Annexure P-31 dated 31.1.2017, the petitioner will be informed of the discrepancies and the supplies will not be stopped for a period of next 30 days after the issuance of the communication in order to enable the petitioner to avail the legal remedy.
