Petitioner has challenged the validity of the award dated 22.08.2014 (Annexure P-5).

Petitioner is stated to have been appointed in the year 1977. His service were terminated on 19.10.1982. He raised demand notice only in the year 2009. Thus, there is a delay of 2 ½ decades. Labour Court has taken note of delay and laches on the part of the petitioner in raising industrial dispute in the year 2009. Pursuant to the order of termination dated 19.10.1982, petitioner has not apprised either before the Labour Court or this Court with regard to delay of about 2 ½ decades in raising industrial dispute. Thus, petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with award passed by the Labour Court dated 22.08.2014 (Annexure P-5).

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
