By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant retiral benefits by taking into account his past service rendered in HSMITC by granting pay protection and to grant all other consequential benefits as has been granted to other similarly situated employees namely Niranjana Singh, Dharam Dass, Giani Ram, who were earlier working as Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar under Housing Board at Hisar and Dharampal working as Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar under Housing Board, Sirsa and interest @ 12% w.e.f. the date the amount becomes due till the actual payment.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to

respondent(s) to decide legal notice dated 31.07.2017 (Annexure P-9), within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 31.07.2017 (Annexure P-9) and to decide the same, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feel aggrieved against the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
