Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the relief sought for in the present petition is covered by the judgment of this Court in ***CWP No.18921 of 2017*** titled as ***Subhash Chander and others vs. Haryana Staff Selection Commission***, decided along with other connected petitions on 14.09.2017.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Addl. AG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Requisite copies of paper book be handed over to the State counsel during the course of the date.

What the petitioners are asking for is that the marks assignable to them on account of the experience they have gained, (as per the criteria fixed by the respondent Commission), need to be added to the marks obtained by them in the written examination taken by the said respondent in the selection process for appointment as Shift Attendants.

In the aforesaid judgment of this Court, that issue has already

been considered, with a direction issued that the marks for experience, as per the criteria laid down by the respondent-Commission itself, being invariable marks, i.e. as many marks as are to be given for such experience, would remain unaltered even after the interview, they should in fact be added to the marks obtained in the written examination, and thereafter persons/candidates be called for interviews, as come within the zone of selection upto twice the number of posts advertised, that are to be filled in.

Consequently, this petition is allowed in the same terms as CWP No.18921 of 2017 and other connected matters.
