Petitioner was subjected to disciplinary proceedings. It was concluded in imposing penalty of dismissal from service on 20.05.2015. He has exhausted the remedy of appeal and further he has presented review/revision on 9.6.2016. Before its finality, he has rushed to this Court in challenging the disciplinary authority's order. Undisputedly, disciplinary authority order is already merged with the appellate authority and further it is pending consideration before the revisional authority. In view of these facts and circumstances, writ petition is not maintainable insofar as challenge to the order of disciplinary authority.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed as premature. Dismissal of this petition would not come in the way of revisional authority in deciding petitioner's review application dated 9.6.2016, at the earliest.
