JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the pension and interest @ 18% per annum on delayed payment in view of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in CA No.256 of 2014 arising out of SLP No.9953 of 2008 (Annexure P-5), with further prayer that petitioner may kindly be compensated in lieu of causing financial loss.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondent(s) to decide legal notice dated 11.11.2014 (Annexure P-8) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in

his legal notice dated 11.11.2014 (Annexure P-8) and to decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
