The claimants have not appealed against the award. The amount awarded to the claimants is ₹2,67,060/-. The medical expenses were not granted because the injured was a Manager in Punjab National Bank and was reimbursed the medical expenses by his employer in terms of his conditions of service.

This is the Insurance Company's appeal and the argument of Mr. R.C. Kapoor, Advocate appears far-fetched for any reduction in the quantum of compensation awarded for the injuries sustained in the road accident. As far as the driving licence is concerned, the issue has been taken up in appeal and is answered against the Insurance Company relying on the authority in 'Mukund Dewangan vs. Oriental Insurance Co. Ltd.', 2017 ACJ 2011 (SC).

No ground for interference is made out.
