The instant writ petition is directed by Union of India against an interim order passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, whereby the order promoting the private-respondents has been stayed on the premise that 'Catch-Up Rule' laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court has not been followed. The stay order has been extended from time to time. The main case is now listed for hearing before the Tribunal on 06.12.2017.

It appears expedient to dispose of this writ petition without expressing any views on merits, with a direction to the Tribunal to decide the main case either on the date fixed or at the earliest and before 28.02.2018.
