Challenge in the instant petition was to the order dated 11.3.2015 (Annexure P-5), passed by the Managing Director, Markfed and whereby an advertisement dated 2.3.2014 for filling up posts of Clerk, Peon and Chowkidar from amongst the seasonal retrenched employees of Sugar Mill, Mallout, was withdrawn.

Counsel appearing for the respondent-Federation apprises the Court that after the filing of the petition the posts were re-advertised and in pursuance to the subsequent exercise, both the petitioners stand appointed as Peons.

Such factual premise would perhaps also explain non-appearance of the counsel for petitioners today as also on the last date of hearing i.e. 16.12.2016.

Writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
