JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to complete the service book of the petitioner and to count the work charge service of the petitioner from 01.12.1976 to 19.07.1988 for the purposes of retiral benefits and the balance of retiral benefits may be paid accordingly along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent(s) to decide legal notice dated 11.09.2017 (Annexure P-3), within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated

11.09.2017 (Annexure P-3) and to decide the same, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feel aggrieved against the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
