Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to re-fix the pay of the petitioner in the light of the order dated December 24, 2008 (P-1) and February 20, 2009 (P-2) wherein the pay rule and experience should be considered by the Markfed of all the employees, who were merged from Cooperative Marketing Societies and to consider the ACPs of 4/9/14 years in a proper and fair manner and to release all consequential benefits with interest @ 18% per annum and further directing the respondents to grant the benefit of 14 years of service under the ACP Scheme by considering/counting the services rendered by the petitioner from the date of joining i.e. November 17, 1986.

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2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a representation was made to the respondent No.1 on December 20, 2016 (P-7) but till date no action has been taken by the concerned Department. However, learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.1 to decide the aforesaid representation (P-7) within some specified period.

3. Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.1 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated December 20, 2016 (P-7) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
