Petitioner herein is the widow of late Constable Harjit Singh, who was initially enrolled as a Special Police Officer on 06.10.1994. Subsequently, husband of the petitioner was selected as Constable on 30.01.2009 and was given constabulary No.575.

Claim raised in the instant petition is for issuance of directions to the respondent/authorities for treating the deceased husband of the petitioner to be governed under the old Pension Scheme applicable to the appointees prior to 01.01.2004 and by granting his previous period of engagement as Special Police Officer.

During the course of hearing today, learned State counsel upon instructions from Sh. Devinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, ADGP Armed Battalion, Jalandhar Cantt. has very fairly stated that the claim of the petitioner would be covered in terms of judgement dated 11.05.2016 passed by this Court in **CWP-11802-2008 (Paramjit Kaur Vs.**

State of Punjab & others).

Accordingly, the instant petition is allowed in terms of judgment rendered by this Court in **Paramjit Kaur's case (supra)**.
