1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to initiate enquiry in the light of Annexures P-1 to P-3 and direction also to be given to respondent No.4 to submit their report in compliance of office letter dated 08.06.2017 issued by respondent No.3 (Annexure P-4).
2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of Section 133 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the appropriate authority in accordance with law.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
