By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to count his previous service i.e. from July 01, 1972 to January 13, 1980 as qualifying service for the purpose of fixation of his pension and other pensionary benefits etc. and release his all due with interest along with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice dated September 27, 2017 (P-5) was made to the respondents but till date no action has been taken. However, learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-5) within some specified period.

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3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-The Director General of Higher Education, Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sector 5, Panchkula to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice September 27, 2017 (P-5) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules and instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
