It is not in dispute that against the order dated 16.10.2017 passed by the DRT-III, appeal is maintainable before the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal, hence, this Court would not like to interfere in the present petition as the petitioners have effective alternative remedy.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners had earlier filed CWP No.26379 of 2017 which was dismissed as withdrawn on 28.11.2017 as there were certain technical errors, however, with liberty to file fresh one. Now the present petition has been filed. In the process, limitation to file appeal before the Appellate Tribunal has expired.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, it is directed that in case, the appeal is filed before the Appellate Tribunal within one week from

today, the same shall not be dismissed on account of delay only.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
