Petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 4.6.2009 (Annexure P-7), whereby respondent No.4 has been granted full back wages for the period 27.10.1994 to 26.2.2008.

Petitioner alleges that an FIR No.66 dated 24.2.1994 was registered against respondent No.4 under sections 366/376/342/506/34 IPC. Petitioner was convicted and sentenced vide order dated 06.04.1996, passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh and was, thus, dismissed from service.

It appears, respondent No.4 filed appeal and was acquitted. As a result, the competent authority granted him full back wages. Petitioner has challenged the order passed in 2009, after a lapse of almost eight years. His locus standi to file the petition is also doubtful. Besides, Forum of this court cannot be used for settling personal scores. Possibilities that petition

has been filed with some oblique motive, cannot be ruled out. No interference in writ jurisdiction is called for.

Dismissed.
