Power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.5 has been filed
in court, which is taken on record.

Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article
226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought for issuance of an
appropriate writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the
respondents No.4 & 5 to pay the retiral benefits such as Gratuity, Leave En-
cashment etc. to the petitioner on his retirement from service of respondent
No.5-Society on attaining the age of superannuation on April 30, 2014
along with interest.

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2. The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that though a legal notice dated March 02, 2016 (Annexure P-2) was issued to The Registrar as well as other officer(s) of the Cooperative Societies, Punjab, but till date no action has been taken by respondents No.4 & 5 i.e. Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Ferozepur and President, The Laley Multipurpose Cooperative Agricultural Service Society Ltd, Ferozepur.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No.4 & 5 to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated March 02, 2016 (Annexure P-2) and take a decision within a period of three months' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, respondents No.4 & 5 comes to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled for relief claimed through legal notice, to disburse the same within next two months'.
