Petitioners are employees of Cooperative Sugar Mills having been retrenched for one reasons or the order.

Instant petition seeks issuance of writ of mandamus for directing the respondent/authorities including the Punjab Agriculture Development Bank, Sector-17 Chandigarh to consider the cases for absorption in terms of Policy dated 06.08.2012.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that the notice (dated nil) at Annexure P-10 was issued by the Punjab State Cooperative Agricultural Development Bank inviting applications for recruitment of Managers/Information Technology Officers/Field Officers and Clerks-cum-Data Entry Operators and in pursuance to which the petitioners have applied. Clause 4 of the such advertisement makes a provision for permanent/regular retrenched employees of closed Cooperative Sugar Mills and Cooperative Spinning Mills in the State of Punjab.

Counsel concedes that the petitioners herein have approached respondent No.4/Bank in pursuance to Clause 4 contained in the advertisement at Annexure P-10.

Concededly, the claim of the petitioners in pursuance to Annexure P-10 has not been rejected till date.

No cause of action, as such, has arisen in favour of the petitioners to invoke the extraordinary writ jurisdiction of this Court.

Confronted with such a situation, counsel prays for withdrawal of the writ petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
