By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to re-fix their pension as per circulars dated 05.10.2011, 09.12.2011 and 15.12.2011 (Annexures P-3 to P-7) in view of increase in the pay scales and grade pay in terms of judgment rendered by this Court in ***CWP No.2866 of 2014, titled as “Karanvir Singh and others v. State of Punjab and others, decided on 30.09.2016*** (P-12) along with number of other writ petitions and consequently grant them all consequential benefits accruing therefrom.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent(s) to decide the legal

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notice dated September 20, 2017 (P-15) in view of the circulars dated 05.10.2011, 09.12.2011 and 15.12.2011 (Annexures P-3 to P-7) as well as judgment of this Court in case *Karanvir Singh (supra)*, within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated September 20, 2017 (P-15) and decide the same particularly in view of circulars dated 05.10.2011, 09.12.2011 and 15.12.2011 (Annexures P-3 to P-7) as well as judgment of this Court in case *Karanvir Singh (supra)* (P-12), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
