The petitioner is aggrieved by the action of the respondents in refusing to issue passport to the petitioner, it being an adoption case.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has apprised this Court of the various requirements which have been enshrined in circular dated 09.05.2015 wherein a check list has been provided for issuance of passport in an adoption case.

In view of said circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case the petitioner submits all the requisite documents as per the check list before the authority, respondent No.2 will decide fresh claim of the petitioner for issuance of the passport within a period of one month, in case the petitioner is found entitled to the passport as per provisions of law applicable in an adoption case.
