As per pleadings on record, petitioner, who was serving as a Safai Sewak under Municipal Council, Mallout, retired on 31.12.2016 upon attaining the age of superannuation.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that entire admissible retiral benefits in the nature of gratuity, leave encashment etc. have not been released till date.

Against the backdrop of such claim and grievance set forth, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition by granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the appropriate authority/competent authority by filing a comprehensive representation.

In the eventuality of any such representation being preferred, the fourth respondent i.e. the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Mallout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib would be obligated to examine the claim and to thereafter proceed in accordance with law. If it is found that certain admissible retiral benefits are still due, the same would be released in favour of the petitioner forthwith.
